

TWIC

Tabasamu Watoto Inclusive Centre was ECI's first Partner and we have been visiting their school since 2016. TWIC is an early childhood inclusive school in Kibera, Kenya. In addition to education, they also provide an abundance of community outreach. ECI works with TWIC to provide community awareness trainings, caregiver trainings, and professional development for TWIC's teachers and other community members. Dennis Ochieng is the founder and principal of TWIC. We work closely with Dennis throughout the year to determine specific needs for each team trip.







Ardent Schools

Ardent Schools is an inclusive
elementary school in Kantafu, Kenya. In
addition to their school, they have Myles
Autism Unit, which allows for
therapeutic services to be provided to
their students with disabilities. ECI and
Ardent schools collaborate to host
yearly community training days for
parents, teachers, and other
professionals in the field. Additionally,
we have specific supports to Ardent's
teachers. Judy is the founder of Ardent
Schools. She has two sons who are both
on the autism spectrum.

ABOUT OUR PARTNERS

Tender Care Institute

Tender Care is ECI's newest partner in Kenya. They are located in the town of Busia, near the Ugandan border. Tender care is a newly opened inclusive and early childhood school. Additionally, they plan to provide a day program and drop-off care to allow caregivers to shop at the local market twice per week. ECI is excited to be working with Tender Care to promote community awareness for individuals with disabilities, as well as to support their teachers in developing the skills to educate their students with disabilities and provide a welcoming learning environment.







Connect2Rwanda

ECI is excited to be collaborating with a multitude of advocates in the city of Musanze, Rwanda. ECI, Ineza Kabaya, L'arc en ciel, and community officials will be working together to increase awareness efforts and educational supports for people with disabilities in the area. Ineza Kabaya is a learning and boarding centre for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and L'arc en ciel is an inclusive early childhood program. District officials are very involved in community developments. We are thrilled for this joint-effort opportunity!



Tentative Itinerary

Week Prior to Travel- 1 Day Team Orientation (typically online)

June 1, 2025- Team Departs Memphis together

Week 1- Team works in and explores Nairobi area (TWIC & Ardent Schools)

Week 2 - Team works in Busia town (Tender Care Inst.) and Musanze, Rwanda

End of Week Two- Excursion in Volcanoes National Park

June 15, 2025- Team returns to the USA











Excursions: Each trip we venture out to see more of the local area. In Kenya, you will have the opportunity to explore different parts of Nairobi; some options include The Giraffe Centre, Elephant Orphanage, safariing in Nairobi National Park, and shopping at a Masai Market. In Rwanda, you will have the opportunity to join an excursion with the team in Volcanoes National Park. We will collect more information on the team's preferences and pick our specific adventures once we get closer to the trip dates. Excursion fees are seperate from trip fees and are not tax deductible.

*Important Items to Note:

- The total cost of the trip can be fundraised.
- Dates may fluctuate by 1 day on either side of the trip depending on flights.
- ECI will book international flights and arrange accommodations, transportation, local meals, and excursions.
- Cost includes room for flight fluctuation and flight costs from Memphis International Airport. For safety and timeline reasons, the team must fly out together.
- If you would like to use airline miles, we can provide you with a modified fundraising amount.
- All donations & payments are tax deductible with the exception of money paid toward excursions.
- **Commitment Fee:** A \$250 commitment fee will be due within 14 days of being accepted for travel. This can be fundraised and counts towards your fundraising total.
- We can provide fundraising support and tips to help you raise the funds for your trip!
